

## **JUMC Watering Instructions:**

- 1.) Lock box for the key to the well pump switch is behind the white shed. Combo: (on written copy)
- 2.) Unlock pump switch box and flip switch to on.
- 3.) Hose and faucet are behind the shed.
- 4.) 2 Crab trees down by the front blue spruce and the 2 maples back by the patio need deep watering at least once a week if there is less than 1 inch of rain. If the summer is very dry, a root soaker will be available behind the shed to deep water the maple trees at least once a week.
- 5.) Flowers and shrubs need deep watering once per week. I tried to make basin around each plant to hold the water and filling each basin twice should be enough. The basins, however, may not be apparent under the mulch. Alternatively, draw the water stream from the hose in a circle around each plant about 5 times per plant should be enough. If we get 1 inch of rain during the week, that would suffice and no additional watering needed. (Chris Gritzmacher).
- 4.) Water plantings by the front signs, around the foundation, and the window boxes, as well as the patio flower bed. Water the planters on the front stoop (they will dry out quickly in hot weather).
- 5.) If you have time, water the grass in the bare spots & newly planted sod created from the construction trucks.
- 6.) When done, flip the pump switch to off, lock the switch box, and return the key to the lock box entering the same combo to lock the box.
