How fitting that the ashes of those who have found solace, joy and inspiration in Jacksonport United Methodist Church be interred near its Memorial Wall. This Wall offers an expression of continuing faith and love. It is conceived to bring assurance of quiet peace for all seasons of the year and to mark the rebirth of life in the beauty of nature.

### ***QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS***

#### ***How are Plots by the Memorial Wall Acquired?***

A minimum donation of \$850.00 will provide a memorial area which will allow from one to four individual internment of ashes. There is an additional fee for a plaque and an engraving fee that normally total about \$100.00. A Memorial Wall permit is issued by the Jacksonport Memorial Wall Trustees. These are designated by number (location of the burial site). All conditions of use are explained in the permit.

#### ***How are Plots Selected?***

Plots may be chosen from those that are available at the time of selection. A plan of the Wall showing the plots can be obtained from the Church Lay Leader or Memorial Wall Trustees.

#### ***How is the Garden Maintained***

The care and maintenance of the Memorial Wall will be under the supervision of the Jacksonport Church Grounds Committee. Trust funds administered by the Foundation provide the means to maintain the Wall and associated plantings.

### ***How May Plots Be Marked***

**Plots are identified by plaques set in the wall. In order to insure simplicity and uniformity, the material, dimension, design and placement of this name plate will be determined by the Memorial Wall Trustees.**

### ***Is the Use of Plots Limited?***

**Yes. Only a member, associate, or affiliate member of Jacksonport United Methodist Church may acquire a permit for the interment of his or her own ashes and those of his or her deceased family. The term "family" shall include the parents, spouses, immediate descendants (including adopted children), spouses of immediate descendants and brothers and sisters of the permit owner up to four interments per single plot.**

### ***What Type of Burial is Allowed?***

**Only ashes of a cremation may be interred in the ground in front of the Wall in the designated plot. The actual burial expenses are the responsibility of the family of the deceased,**

### ***May I Contribute Without Purchasing a Plot?***

**Yes. Any contributions is welcome for maintenance of the landscaping, wall, or plaques. Such gifts are tax deductible.**

### ***May I Divide My Payments?***

**Yes, with a written agreement that defines the anticipated payment schedule. You will be assigned a plot number when the final payment is received.**
